

Intermountain Machine and Fabricating

Roy Schumacher owner and operator of Intermountain Machine and Fabricating gave us the grand tour of his new 80' x 160' building that will house his operations and business office. This new facility is located on Highway 13 east of Grangeville. The facility boasts two miles of heat coil in the floor that is connected to a water boiler system. The new facility will also house Aqua Source a well drilling and pump installation business. Roy has worked out of a building just east of his new facility for the last eight years.



In addition to being a job shop and fabrication facility Intermountain Machine and Fabricating builds a road packer that attaches to the back end of graders that compacts the soil. They are also making a shock absorber for a drilling machine that prevents the drilling machine from being damaged when it hits hard surfaces.

Roy says they currently employ ten and are planning on expanding when they are in the new facility.
